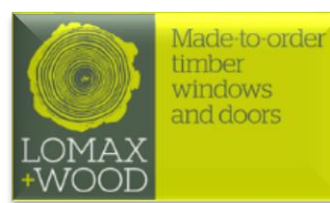


Chain of Custody

What is it?

Chain of Custody is the unbroken path between the “forest gate” and the end user, including all stages of processing, manufacture, sales and distribution. By having FSC Certification it enables us to say “This product has been made with wood from well-managed forests and we can prove it.”

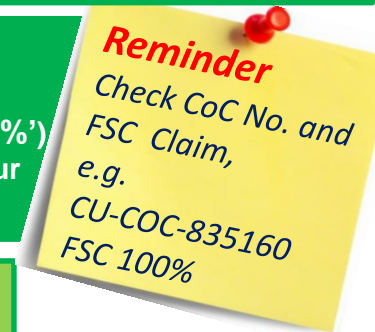
FSC – Forest Stewardship Council is an independent organisation that promotes the responsible management of the world’s forests. The FSC label provides a credible link between responsible production and consumption of forest products, enabling consumers and businesses to make purchasing decisions that benefit people and the environment as well as providing ongoing business value.



PEFC – Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification schemes shares some common aims with FSC in promoting the sustainable management of forests but differences in emphasis and interpretation of forest management criteria, and some philosophical differences as well, make it difficult for FSC to recognise PEFC as a credible process. Lomax+Wood has not pursued PEFC Certification as the products we currently supply are manufactured from FSC timber.

How does it work?

Our Company purchases wood products from other FSC Certified companies. When we receive the goods, we must check that the delivery note and invoice details the supplier’s CoC Registration No. and FSC Claim (e.g. ‘FSC 100%’, ‘FSC Mix Credit’ or ‘FSC Mix 70%’) to confirm they are certified. We then pass on this claim with our Registration No. onto our customers via our own sales documents.



Who Checks?

We are certified and audited by BM TRADA, an independent certification body that is accredited by FSC to ensure that certified companies comply with the scheme requirements.
